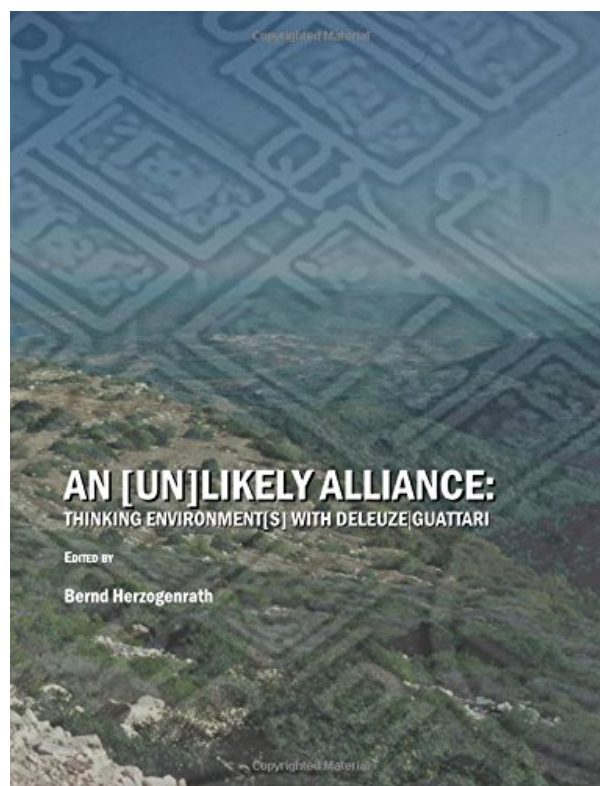
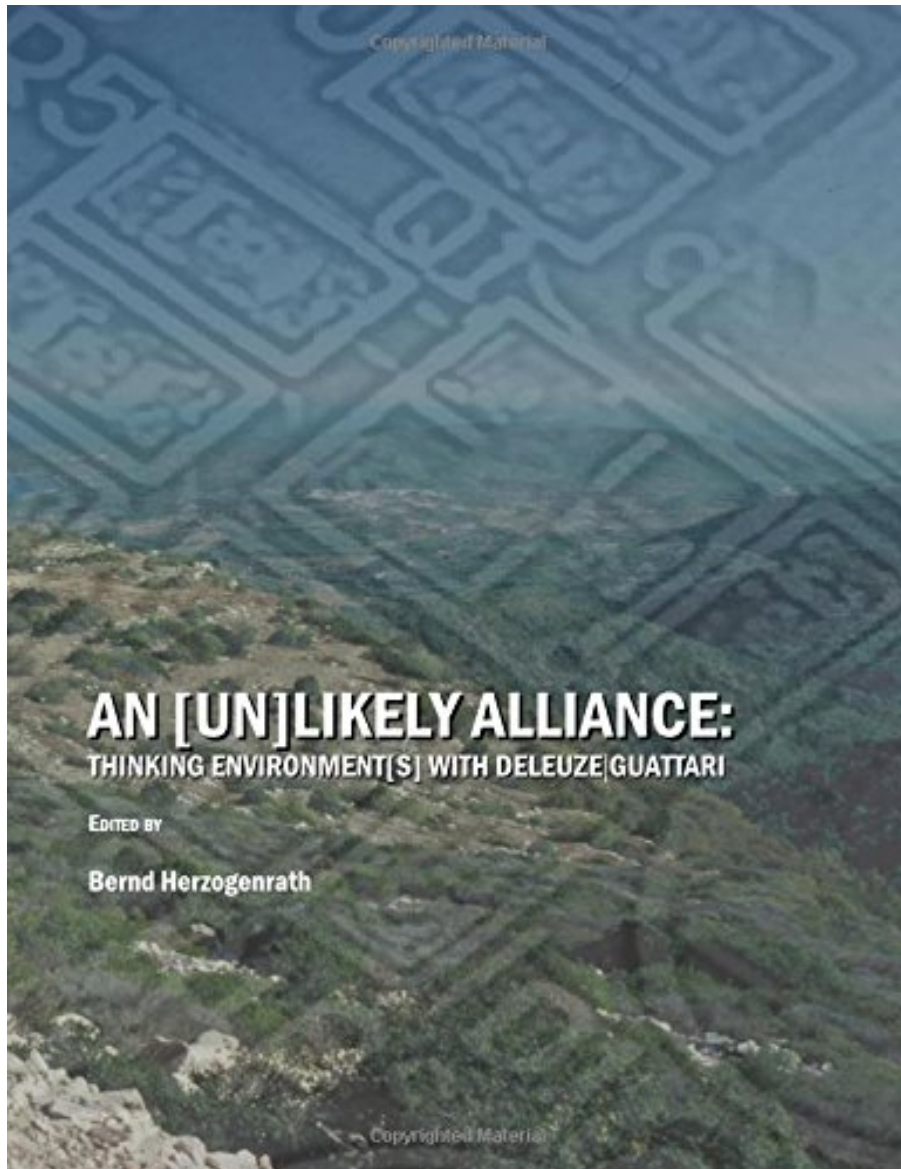

At a time when more and more artists (not to mention scientists!) operate on the threshold between biology and technology, the separation between the natural and the technological|cultural seems, as Deleuze|Guattari maintain, no longer tenable. This book thus aims at a radical re-thinking of these concepts from a Deleuzian|Guattarian (i.e. non-dualist and materialist) perspective.
