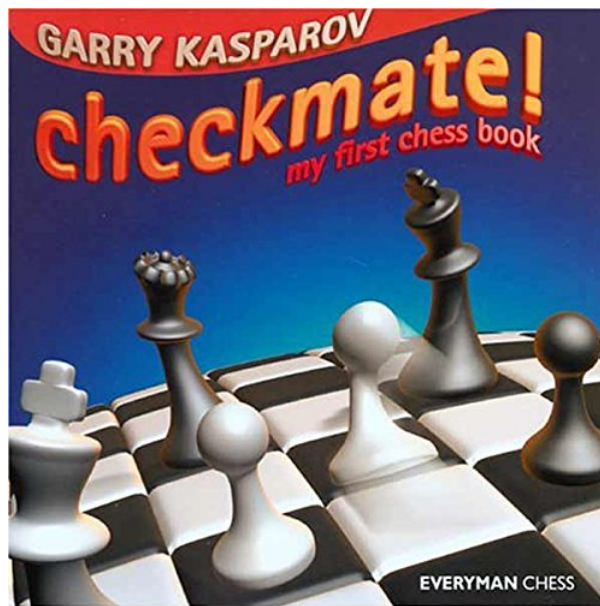
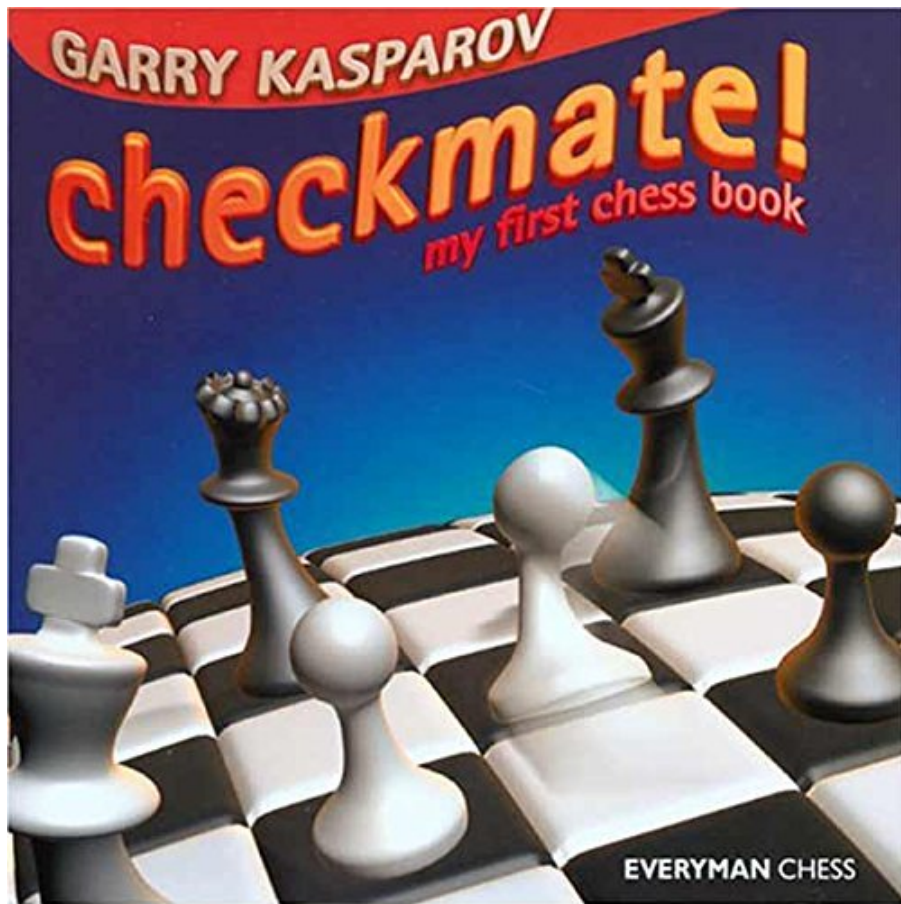

For a beginning player, the graphics are well done. Geared to a younger audience, the rules are explained so as to enhance retention. The examples in the back are well known to experienced players, but help the novice to more easily get up to speed.

Normally, someone of Kasparov's calibre is too far removed from the beginning level to explain things easily. This isn't the case here. I put this in our middle school library to help budding players get started. I've recommended it to others and will do so again for aspiring chess players.

Yesterday I took a magnetic chess board I bought on Amazon to my weekly visit with an 86 year old friend who had stated a desire to try learning chess again. (We had both played with little skill or knowledge when we were younger.) I went online to find us the basics so we could stumble our way through our first game. I had this book when I got home and started reading it. I have already found three important moves we did not know about. (Granted, we were too impatient to read all the way through the online instruction!) Castling, pawns capturing pawns "en passant", and promoting pawns that reach the far side of the board will certainly make chess even more challenging!

I think the typeface will be easy for Nelda to read, and the graphical board representations are easier to see than some other books I paged through. The "3D" images may be harder for her to make out; that remains to be seen. I think the hardback format will also be easier for her to handle than a paperback, even if they typeface in the paperbacks were not too hard to read.

You don't need to be a child to appreciate this book. At 56 I am not ashamed to say I am finding it quite useful.
