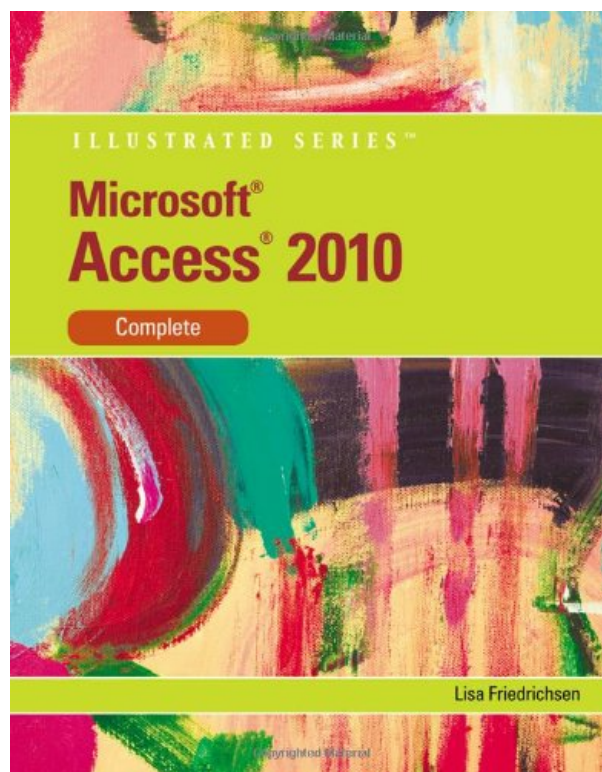
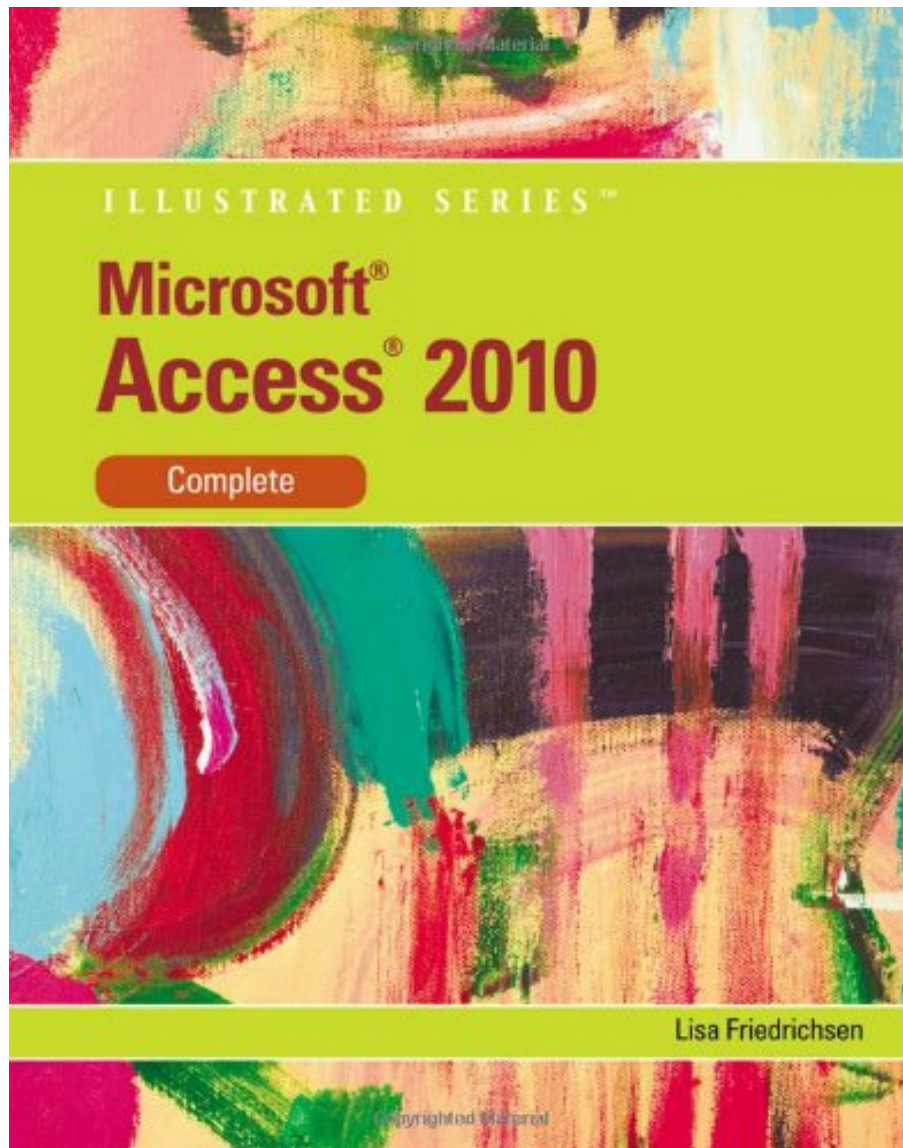

I have been involved in computing for over thirty-five years. To give you some idea of what this means, I started in the days prior to PCs when punch cards were king and "big iron" mainframes ruled the roost. A
